COMPETITORS INFORMATION

Dear Competitors,

Welcome to the 2011 karting season. **The AMC/RMC Round 1 will be held at Subang Jaya, Selangor and back to Speedway Elite circuit.**

You have been very supportive of the events organized by us and we thank you all for your kind support. We now ask you again to show us your support by your early submission of entries before the dateline for the Round 1. We ask for your cooperation by submitting your entries as early as possible so that we are able to get everything in order for you. In order for us to guarantee the smooth running of the event, we appreciate if you could obey the following guidelines.

- **Entries**

The race will be held in Subang Jaya, as scheduled on **12/13 March**. Entries are open from now until **25 February, 2011**. Entry forms and SR are already available and are published in the KartingAsia, Kartmore Racing web pages. Please arrange to have your entries submitted to the Race Secretariat now as it will save the organizer a lot of time in compiling the entries. If you send them late, your entry may not appear in the programme as well as having to pay double entry fees. You can submit your name and details by email and fax first.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ONCE WE REACH THE REQUIRED 34 DRIVERS IN A CLASS WE WILL CLOSE THE ENTRY LIST EVEN IF THE DATELINE IS NOT MET!!!

Please ensure that you have a Release letter from your ASN if you are a foreign competitor.

Fax or email your entry to the race secretariat first and bring the original to the signing in.

Make sure your license is in order for the class that you have entered.

Foreign competitors must have an International grade C license or a National C license as a minimum. ALL FOREIGN COMPETITORS MUST HAVE A RELEASE LETTER FROM THEIR OWN ASN.

Beer and other liquor are widely available at Supermarkets. Pubs are available at most places and at the hotel.

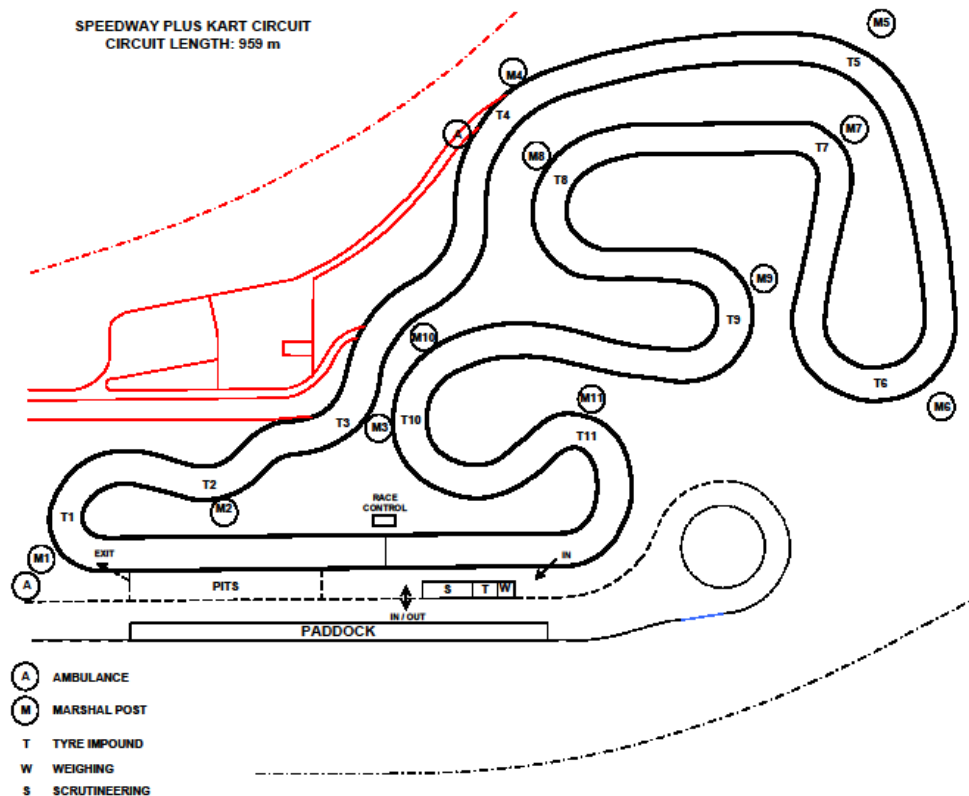
The Kart Track

The track is 6 km away from the hotel located along the Elite Highway to the airport near the USJ toll turnoff. Tents will be available for rental to all foreign and local competitors. Cost of rental per tent which can house 4 karts as well as ample working space is RM300.00. There is electricity available in the pit area as well as compressed air in the Parc Ferme.

The track is 959 m long with 11 turns. Lap time of 43.7 - 44 sec clockwise direction. Sprocket used is 12-78 to 84. The track has undergone renovation with new tyre walls done. Area of the road which has broken up has been repaired.

There will be security at the track from Thursday until Sunday. However, we want to remind all competitors to be extra careful with their equipment. We will try our best to ensure security is available at all times.

Tyres

For the Formula Cadet class only DELI tyres will be allowed and for all the Rotax Max classes only MOJO D2 tyres will be used. You can bring your own tyres for practice. BUT you will be required to purchase ONE and half set from the Organisers during signing in and this set will be marked by the scrutineers to be used entirely for the race meeting. PLEASE NOTE THAT WE WILL BE USING MOJO **D2 CIK HOMOLOGATED** TYRES FOR ALL ASIA MAX and RMC RACES for 2011. For Wet tyres you are allowed to scrutineer either new or used One and half set. PLEASE NOTE THAT ONLY MOJO WET TYRES W1, W2 OR W3 WILL BE ALLOWED.

- **Fuel and Lubricants**

Fuel is available at the nearby Caltex Service station not far from the track. We will designate that station to supply all the fuel for the competitors. FUEL TESTS WILL BE CONDUCTED. 2T will be available for sale at the track. If you have a preference for your own brand of 2T you will have to bring them yourself.

- **Drug Test**

We have been asked by our ASN to inform all competitors that drug taking during the course of a race is an offence. The Stewards may conduct random drug tests on competitors. **BE WARNED.**
