COMPETITORS INFORMATION

Dear Competitors,

Welcome to Pekan, Pahang again and to a further revised kart circuit! This is round 4 of the Rotax Asia Zone Challenge and it will be exciting for all drivers to be competing on this circuit after a tiring race in Kuching.

The race will be held at the Inderapura Lake Resort circuit located in Royal town of Pekan. Pekan is about 40km from the major city of Kuantan where all the action is. The official hotel is located in Kuantan. Kuantan is approximately 350km from Kuala Lumpur. Travel to Kuantan by road is by the tolled expressway. Average travel time from Kuala Lumpur to Kuantan is about 3 hours.

In order for us to guarantee the smooth running of the event, we appreciate if you would obey the following guidelines.

- **Entries**

The race will be held in Pekan, in the state of Pahang on 23 and 24 July. This race is held in conjunction with the birthday celebration of His Highness the Regent of Pahang who by the way is also an avid ex-karter.

Entries are open from now until 11 July, 2011. Entry forms and SR are already available and are published in the KartingAsia, Kartmore Racing web pages. If you need an entry form, please contact chan@kartmoreracing.com

Fax or email your entry to the race secretariat first and bring the original to the signing in. Kindly ensure that you have filled up all your details in the original entry form. **All entry forms MUST BE ACCOMPANIED with full payment of**

the entry fees of RM350.00. Entries without payment will not be allocated the free hotel room.

Make sure your license is in order for the class that you have entered.
Foreign competitors must have an International grade C license or a National license as a minimum.

Please ensure that you have a Release letter from your ASN if you are a foreign competitor.

This hotel will house all the competitors and families. The Organiser is offering free 3 nights stay for competitors at this hotel from Friday to Monday. Hotel to track will take about 45 minutes. The hotel is within walking distance to shopping complexes, cultural zone attractions and offices. We will be issuing a room booking form for you to indicate the number of rooms you require and any extra beds etc. Please complete the form and return to us in due time. You may want to stay at another hotel on your own and there are many good hotels available in Kuantan.

BOOKING OF ROOMS WILL CLOSE ON 11 JULY, 2011. IF YOU HAVE NOT BOOKED YOUR ROOM BY THEN YOU WILL HAVE TO LOOK FOR YOUR OWN ACCOMODATION.

Car Rental:

Rental cars are available at the KLIA airport as well as at Kuantan airport also. Average size car would cost about RM120.00 per day. Vans would cost more in the region of RM200.00 upwards.

Food:

Pekan is off the tourist track but a wide range of food is still available. There will be catering facilities at the track for everyone at moderate prices. There are several places further away from the track which has many eating shops.

Kuantan is a tourist city. Seafood is abundantly available as well as beer and other liquor. Pubs are available at most places and at the hotel in Kuantan.

The Kart Track

The track is located in the Inderapura Lake Resort and is a permanent circuit using part of the resort road. As with the race in 2010, the new start/finish straight has been laid and also doubled up as a drag strip. A new grand stand has been built and drivers' briefing will be held there. Tents for all competitors will be provided by the Organiser. However, due to the limited number of tents available we will make sure that all competitors will have at least a shared tent. On the hospitality tents required by the Teams, we will try to accommodate as much as possible. There is electricity available in the pit areas as well as compressed air at Parc Ferme.

The track is 950 m long. Racing is in the anti-clockwise direction. Most of the competitors in this year's AMC/RMC have raced in Pekan before on the revised circuit so you would have all the data you require.

There will be security at the track from Thursday until Sunday. However, we wish to remind all competitors to be extra careful with their equipment. We will try our best to ensure security is available at all times.

The track will be opened for unofficial practice from Saturday 16 July until Friday 22 July.

THE NEW REVISED PEKAN CIRCUIT

- **Tyres**

For the Formula Micromax class, only DELI slick tyres will be allowed and the wet tyres will be MOJO W1 or W2. All the Rotax Max classes only MOJO D2 slick tyres and W1/W2 wet tyres will be used. You can bring your own tyres for practice. BUT you will be required to purchase ONE AND HALF set from the Organisers during signing in and these will be marked by the Scrutineers to be used entirely for the race meeting.

PLEASE NOTE THAT WE WILL BE USING MOJO **D2 CIK** TYRES FOR ALL ASIA MAX and RMC RACES for 2011. Wet tyres will be MOJO W1 or W2.

- **Fuel and Lubricants**

Fuel is available at the nearby Shell Service station not far from the track. We will designate that station to supply all the fuel for the competitors. FUEL TESTS WILL BE CONDUCTED. 2T will be available for sale at the track. If you have a preference for your own brand of 2T you will have to bring them yourself. KARTCARE products will be available for sale at the Rotax Service tent.

In addition, there are a limited supply of battery operated plastic pumps and mechanic's gloves for sale.

- **Drug Test**

We have been asked by our ASN to inform all competitors that drug taking during the course of a race is an offence. The Stewards may conduct random drug tests on competitors. BE WARNED.

We have come across cases of drivers smelling of alcohol on the starting grid. If we come across any driver having alcohol in their system, they will be DQ immediately.
