ROK Malaysia Championship 2006 Round 3

Held for the very first time this year at the PLUS Elite Speedway track – the action on the very technical track was intense and close for all categories!



Using Apexi tyres this round (a cousin of the Duro tyres – as used in Rd 2), the racing was close and intense. Some drivers had issues with tyres again with a suspicion on inconsistent tyre quality a possible cause. To ensure fair play – some of the affected drivers were allowed replacements by the officials with scrubbed front tyres.

The weather was hot and hazy, no thanks to the heat wave we had just before the race weekend. Nevertheless, action on track was equally hot and the competitiveness of the ROK karts dicing well with the Max karts during the races - was welcomed by both drivers and spectators alike.

In total, approximately 30 drivers took part in this round 3 – with some regulars missing the round due to a formula bmw event on the very same day.
